NIT Raipur Sets up 32nd Fastest Supercomputer in India

NIT Raipur has set up **32nd Fastest Supercomputer** as per the latest Top Supercomputers List released by **CDAC** in July 2019. It is an **HPC cluster supercomputer** having a Linpack benchmark performance of 39.5 TFLOPS at the setup in the Advanced Computing Facility under the Systems & Networks



Division of its Central Computer Center. NIT Raipur is the only NIT which has made entry into the prestigious CDAC List. The establishment of the supercomputer would impetus provide to computational research

by enabling large scale high-resolution simulations in science and engineering disciplines.
