Tenth Convocation of the Institute

The 10th convocation of NIT Raipur was held on 1st Dec. 2019, conferring degrees to all the graduating and post-graduating students. The occasion was graced by Mr. Abidali Neemuchwala, Chief Executive Officer (CEO) and Managing Director (MD) of Wipro, and the alumnus of Institute (B.E. from erstwhile Govt. of Engineering College, Raipur in 1990) as the Chief Guest of the ceremony. Over the course of a long and distinguished career, Mr. Abidali has served for 27 years in the global IT industry. The function was presided over by Dr. A. M. Rawani, Director and Acting Chairman of Board of Governor (BOG), NIT Raipur, who presented the Presidential address and the Institute's report highlighting the key achievements of Institute.

Chief Guest Mr. Neemuchwala addressed the gathering and congratulated the graduating students.
