

Institute News

NIRF 2021: 64th Rank (Engineering Category)



NIT Raipur has secured 64th rank in Engineering Category in the National Institutional Ranking Framework 2021 (NIRF) released by the Ministry of Education, Government of India on 9th Sept., 2021. NIT Raipur also stands 16th among the 31 NITs in India. It is the 4th consecutive year for NIT Raipur in which the Institute ranking has improved from 81st in 2018 to 74th in 2019, 67th in 2020, and now it is 64th in 2021. The Institute has been consistently improving its NIRF ranking under the adroit guidance of Dr. A. M. Rawani, Director, NIT Raipur. This coveted and incredible accomplishment is a resultant outcome from the robust academic reforms, a substantial learner's centric ecosystem, significant industrial collaborations, start-up incubations, the worldwide research-output dissemination, and the augmentation of public awareness and outreach activities. Faculty members, students, staff and alumni of the Institute have been insistently and relentlessly working to improve and achieve the vision and mission of the Institute at the national level.

75th Independence Day Celebration

NIT Raipur celebrated the 75th Independence Day in the Institute campus with patriotic and nationalistic fervour. Dr. A. M. Rawani, *Director*, *NIT Raipur* hoisted the National Flag at the Institute Garden. Honouring the glorious occasion amidst the unprecedented challenges of the COVID-19 pandemic. In his Independence Day speech, he spoke about the leaps of infrastructure progress, teaching and research innovations that have ushered over the past four years in the Institute. He also expressed his grief and sorrow about the loss of the cherished people of the Institute due to the Covid-19. Underlining the sharp enhancement of global and national perception and impact of the Institute, Honourable Director congratulated the PMRC of NIT Raipur for its commendable efforts in establishing a growing social, electronic, and print-media presence of the Institute. Further, in these trying times of COVID-19, he

appreciated the efforts of the Institute in the completion of the faculty recruitment process, which was conducted virtually. He also spoke about developing the Technology Hub and Business Incubation Centre, NIT Raipur, which would be established in this academic year. For this development, the Board of Governors (BoG), NIT Raipur approved an Innovation and Start-up Policy 2021, which includes the provisions for faculty members to get involved in an innovation and start-up project. The Director also informed about the creation of donation fund namely **Support to Covid Affected Students**, which will be utilized to provide financial support for full/partial Academic Fee Payment of such students of NIT Raipur who have lost their earning parent in the Covid-19 pandemic.





Looking ahead, the Honourable Director acknowledged that the future goals of the Institute Vision-2030 would focus on the foundation of the Innovation and Entrepreneurship ecosystem, the development of Incubation Center and the establishment of Multi-disciplinary Research Projects. In this regard, he mentioned that the new draft Vision-2030 document of the Institute has been compiled and the draft is available on the Institute's Website for feedbacks from its stakeholders - the students, employees and alumni. He also highlighted the various initiative and developments of the Institute that have been taken into consideration for aiming to implement the New Educational Policy (NEP-2020). He said that most of the developments under NEP-2020 would not only bring the flexibility to our academic curriculum and teaching-learning process, but it would also help our faculty members to upskill their knowledge. Further, he decreed a new online department-wise, Institute lecture series for the students, featuring speakers worldwide and for a better Teacher-Students relation he announced semester wise **Edutainment Sessions** in all the departments.

The entire event was physically attended by a few faculty members following the COVID-19 protocol, while other members, staff and students witnessed the celebration through an online virtual medium, which was live-streamed on the Institute's official Social media platforms - *YouTube Channel*, *Facebook Page* and *Instagram account*.

Recruitment of Faculty Members

Interviews for faculty positions in various departments were conducted in the month of April, May, and June 2021. Sixty internal faculty members were offered upgradation to higher academic grade pay. Thirty-four appointment letters for the post of Assistant Professor have also been offered to fresh candidates. Inauguration of Data Center, NIT Raipur



Data Center (DC) of **NIT Raipur** was inaugurated by **Dr. A. M. Rawani,** *Director*, NIT Raipur, on 15th Sep., 2021. The

primary purpose of DC is to control, compute and maintain the Institute's back-end information and communication technology (ICT) systems. Further, the DC will develop and preserve the digital data, including the adequate processing, the enhancement of storage capacity, the communication channels, and connecting the servers and databases. The Hon'ble Director also dedicated two Data Center Services to the Institute, i.e., the Video Library and the Departmental Data Storage. These DCs are designed to function round the clock by providing state of the art facilities to secure a safe place for ICT equipment of the Institute. **Dr. B. Acharya**, *Head*, *Central Computer Center*, and **Mr. S. Pandey**, *Senior Technical Officer*, *IT*, elaborated and introduced these services to Institute faculty and staff members. The overall cost in developing this DC is about Rs 4.7Crore.

NIMCET 2021

NIT, Raipur is acting as the coordinating institute for the conduction of NIT MCA Common Entrance Test (NIMCET) 2021. **Dr. A. M. Rawani,** *Director, NIT Raipur* is the Chairman of the National Level Apex committee constituted to oversee the conduction of the examination and **Dr. P. Y. Dhekne,** *Associate Professor, Department of Mining Engineering* is the Secretary of the committee. The computer-based test for NIMCET 2021 was conducted on 7th Aug., 2021 in 68 cities across India following Covid- 19 guidelines. There were 11514 candidates due for the examination and 9434 candidates appeared in the examination. The result was declared on 23rd Aug., 2021 and 6774 candidates have been shortlisted for counselling, which is in progress presently.


Online Edutainment Session




