73rd Republic Day Celebration

NIT Raipur joined the Nation in celebrating the 73rd Republic Day on 26th January 2022 with great zeal and patriotism, while following all the preventive measures of COVID-19 pandemic. Commemorating this historic day, **Dr. A. M. Rawani**, *Director*, *NIT Raipur* unfurled the tricolour flag, followed by the National Anthem. The celebration based on the theme 'Azadi Ka Amrit **Mahotsav**' was broadcasted live on the Institute's website and official social media handles like YouTube, Facebook, and Instagram. While addressing the gathering and the online viewers, the Director, NIT Raipur remembered the two martyrs from the Institute Lt. Arvind Shankar Dixit and Lt. Pankaj Vikram, who sacrificed their lives for our nation.



The director also apprised the audience about the installation of the digital display boards in the institute building, which will be used in place of plastic banners and posters for disseminating information regarding the conferences, seminars, training programs, etc, as one more step towards protecting the environment. Further, he also apprised the audience about the installation of 490-kW capacity solar power plant in the campus to promote use of renewable energy.

Highlighting the future perspectives of the Institute, he informed about the commencement of the Master of Science (MSc.) programs under the science streams of Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics from the session 2022-23 as recommended by the Senate. To further strengthen the research environment, the Honourable Director initiated the organizing of **Annual Research Scholars'** Conclave for Ph.D. scholars of the Institute to present their research findings. He also emphasized on skill development of students through **Refresher courses for Skill development** and to strengthen the ecosystem for placement, he initiated the organizing of **Annual Recruiters' Conclave**. In order to acknowledge the contributions of the non-teaching employees, he announced the initiation of the **Employee of the Quarter Award**. Several other initiatives like **Biannual Parents' Meet** and **training program on Practical Aspects of Intellectual Property Rights** were also announced by the Director on this occasion.

International Conference on Applications of Intelligent Computing in Engineering and Science 2022


