Discussion: Dean (P&D) apprised the house that several abandoned structures like I-

type Quarters, H-type Quarters and Pump house are there in the existing

campus.

A committee was constituted earlier comprising of Expert faculty from the Civil Engineering Department, Executive Engineer from CPWD as an External Expert member, Executive Engineer – Estate Office and other members from the institute which had submitted its recommendations that all such H-type Quarters should be declared abandoned and should be dismantled. These recommendations were approved by the then Director

on 21/04/2014.

Presently, the aforesaid structures not only exist in a dangerous condition, but are also creating obstruction at some places for the construction of OHT, sewer lines, water supply line and STP in the campus, and hence

need to be dismantled immediately.

Resolution: After discussion, the BWC approved dismantling of 4 blocks of H-type

Quarters and 1 Pump house that are obstructing the construction of OHT,

sewer lines, water supply line and STP in the existing campus of NIT

Raipur and that the dismantling is to be done by CPWD.
